



Submission Requirements and Guidelines

Enchanting Plateau Art Exhibition 2025 Submission Requirements & Guidelines

The Enchanting Plateau Art Exhibition invites artists to participate in its upcoming Art Exhibition celebrating the beauty, culture, and resilience of Plateau State.

The following guidelines apply to all entries.

1. Eligibility

- Open to all artists.
- Both emerging and established artists are encouraged to participate.
- Each artist may submit a maximum of five (5) artworks.

2. Theme

All artworks must align with the exhibition's theme: ***ONE!***

Participants are encouraged to creatively interpret the essence of the theme.

3. Acceptable Art Forms

- Painting
- Drawing
- Sculpture
- Photography
- Mixed Media
- Textile

4. Artwork Specifications

- Originality: Must be the artist's original work — no reproductions, traced, or AI-generated pieces.
- Presentation: All artworks must be framed, mounted, or otherwise ready for display.
- Labeling: Clearly state the artist's name, title of artwork, medium, and year of creation on the back/base of the artwork.
- Condition: Must be stable, dry, and suitable for transport and display.

5. Submission Requirements

- Complete registration form on the official website: enchantingplateau.com.
- High-quality images of artwork (front and side views for sculptures).
- A brief artist statement (maximum 150 words) explaining the concept or inspiration.
- Submission deadline: 15th November, 2025
- **NOTE:** Registration and submission offers the artist an option of participating in the art competition with N2,500,000 to be won across the five categories: drawing, sculpture, photography, mixed media, and painting.

6. Judging Criteria

Entries will be evaluated by a professional jury panel based on:

1. Creativity & Originality
2. Relevance to the Theme
3. Technique & Composition
4. Emotional and Cultural Impact
5. Presentation & Finish

7. Awards & Recognition

- Winners will receive certificates and cash prizes.
- Selected artworks will be exhibited and featured in event catalogs and promotional media.
- Exceptional works may be considered for post-exhibition opportunities.

8. Terms & Conditions

- All artworks remain the property of the artist.
- The exhibition reserves the right to photograph and use submitted works for publicity purposes.
- Late or incomplete submissions will not be accepted.
- The jury's decision is final and binding.
